

January 2022 Report for the Town of High Level

January calls for service showed an increase over last month with 277 total reported calls within the Town of High Level.

There were 18 total reported assaults; of these 14 were common assault, 2 were an Assault with a Weapon or Causing Bodily Harm, 1 aggravated assault and 1 assault on a police officer. Charges have been laid on 12 of those investigations with 2 were cleared by other means. There was 1 forcible confinement complaint leading to charges. There were 2 sexual assaults reported, both are still under investigation.

There were 2 complaints of criminal harassment, both were unfounded. There was 1 complaint of harassing communications which is still under investigation. There were 5 complaints of uttering threats 1 was unfounded and 4 are still under investigation.

There were 12 traffic offences complaints, 1 charge for insurance coverage violations, and 1 charge for non-moving traffic violation. The others were cleared either by discretion or are still under investigation.

There was 1 charge under the Cannabis Act. There was also a call of an impaired driver, which led to a traffic stop and charges for possession for the purpose of trafficking a large quantity of cocaine.

There were 3 complaints of impaired drivers with 1 cleared using immediate roadside sanctions, the other two were not located by members on patrol.

There were 11 traffic collisions, 8 resulted in damages to property, 3 were non-reportable damages.

There were 7 Liquor Act related incidents, and were cleared with officer discretion and the subjects were lodged until they were sober and able to care for themselves.

There were 49 calls for mischief/damage to property or obstruction of enjoyment of property resulting in 3 charges laid, 4 were unfounded and the rest were cleared using discretion.

There were 6 firearm related investigations which lead to 4 charges. There were 2 other weapons complaints, charges were laid on one file, one is under investigation, and the other was unfounded.

There was 1 reported theft under \$5000 complaint leading to an arrest on other charges. There was 1 complaint of possession of stolen property, a vehicle, resulting in numerous charges including possession of a prohibited firearm.

There were 3 complaints of Fraud which are still under investigation.

There were 8 reports of missing persons, all have been located. There were 13 well being checks/assistance to the General Public and 9 mental health calls where individuals were referred to or dealt with via the hospital mental health services.

There were 16 reported 911 calls of which 7 were unfounded.

There were 20 complaints of failing to comply with various court orders which resulted in 17 charges being laid and 3 cleared with officer discretion.

Cpl. Sam HOLM and Cpl. Jason BARBER completed a live Town Hall Meeting on January 12, 2022 with the assistance of the Town of High Level to answer policing questions from the public. Another Town Hall meeting will take place in March.
