

July 2022 Report for the Town of High Level

The call volume for the month of July was on par with June as there were 671 calls for service within the Town of High Level, however the call volume did tail off towards the end of the month.

There were 5 drug related investigations which are still ongoing.

There were 31 total reported assaults; of these 18 were common Assault, 4 Aggravated assault, 7 were an Assault with a Weapon or Causing Bodily Harm and 2 assault on a police officer. There were 17 charges laid as a result of these complaints, 6 cleared where the Complainant declined charges or there was insufficient evidence and 2 determined to be unfounded.

There were also 1 complaint of an attempted child abduction from Centennial Park which is currently still under investigation, the Victim and mother has not been identified.

There were 1 complaints of harassing communications, with insufficient evidence to proceed. There were 5 complaints of uttering threats, with 2 cleared otherwise, 1 resulting in charges being laid and 2 deemed to be unfounded. There was 1 reported robbery of a bank card resulting in 1 charge being laid.

There were 32 traffic related complaints, with 20 Provincial charges laid for various infractions.

There were 8 reported traffic collisions resulting in property damage and minor injuries in one case. There was also one hit and run complaint, the suspect had fled the scene but was later identified and charged for failing to remain at the scene of an accident.

There were 4 operating a motor vehicle while impaired complaints. 2 resulted in a road side fail sample, 1 caution sample and 1 insufficient evidence to locate the vehicle.

There were 136 Liquor Act related incidents, and 133 were cleared with officer discretion and the subjects were lodged until they were sober and able to care for themselves. 3 were unfounded.

There were 89 calls for mischief/damage to property or obstruction of enjoyment of property resulting in 1 charge being laid, 2 are still under investigation, 62 were cleared using discretion, insufficient evidence or other.

There were 14 reported thefts under \$5000 complaints resulting in 1 charge being laid, 3 cleared using officer discretion, 3 deemed unfounded. There was 1 theft of a motor vehicle which was recovered later, no charges laid due to insufficient evidence.

There were 3 complaints of break and enter resulting in 1 charges being laid.

There were 2 complaints of possession of stolen property which resulted in a charges being laid on both files.

There were 8 reports of missing persons, all have been located, one was deemed unfounded.

There were 9 firearms related complaints received which resulted in 7 charges being laid, the other 2 were cleared otherwise.

There were 55 miscellaneous calls including well being checks, assistance to the General Public, Suspicious persons/vehicles, animal calls and false alarms. There were 4 mental health related calls where individuals were referred to or dealt with via the hospital mental health services.

There were 27 complaints for failing to comply with court orders, 17 calls for disturbing the peace, 2 obstruction/resisting arrest files. These complaints resulted in 26 charges being laid, 15 cleared using officer discretion or other means.
