**A BYLAW TO REPEAL LOCAL IMPROVEMENT TAX BYLAW NO. 986-18**

**WHEREAS** the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26 (hereinafter referred to as “the Act), as amended, provides that a municipality has the power to pass a bylaw for municipal purposes; and

**WHEREAS** the Act empowers a council of a municipality to pass a bylaw which omits or provides for the repeal of a bylaw or provision of a bylaw that is inoperative, obsolete, expired, spent, or otherwise ineffective; and

**WHEREAS** the Council of the Town of High Level, in the Province of Alberta, deems it appropriate to repeal certain bylaws.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Town of High Level, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be referred to as the “Repealing Local Improvement Tax Bylaw”.
2. THAT Bylaw No. 986-18 be repealed.
3. This Bylaw shall come into force upon third and final reading.

**READ A SECOND TIME** this 8<sup>th</sup> day of June 2020.

**READ A THIRD AND FINAL TIME** this 8<sup>th</sup> day of June 2020.
