  - 2023 OPAC Wildlife Research Permit to be applied for after January 1st 2023, for the 2023 device collection.
  - Year 3 final report and summary due to the Government of Alberta (OPAC) by December 31st 2023.
  - Develop Year 2 and Year 3 webpages are final reports are received – add the photos to Google Drive folders for ease of download by the public (manual process).
